Modifiers. Modifiers can be alphabetic, numeric or a combination of both, but will always be two digits for Medicare purposes. Some modifiers cause automated pricing changes, while others are used to convey information only. Pricing modifiers (NU, RR, or UE), where applicable, should be in the first modifier position. When billing 2 units of a capped rental item, modifiers RT and LT must be in positions two and three. Overflow modifiers, 99 or KB, must be in the 4th modifier position when utilized. Other modifiers can be in any position and the DME MAC will.

Establishment of Medicare Fees for Newly Covered Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS) Sections 1834 (a), (h), and (i) of the Social Security Act mandate that the fee schedule amounts for durable medical equipment (DME), prosthetic devices, prosthetics and orthotics, and surgical dressings, respectively, be calculated based on average reasonable charges paid for the item or device under Medicare from a past period ("the base year").
